

Submission

Submissions of Abstract and Short paper

Participants are invited to submit their abstract (*oral, rountable, poster*) with 200-250 words using the template provided on the conference website for acceptance before **16 May 2021**. All abstracts will be blind reviewed.

The deadline for receiving original short papers (**4 pages + references**) for publication in the Conference Proceedings will be **30 October 2021**. The papers will be blind reviewed. Guidelines for the short paper submission will be communicated after the conference.

Presentations

➤ Oral

All Presentations will be for 10-15 minutes followed by 5 minutes for Questions.

➤ Roundtable

We are proposing 2 options for the Roundtable as follows:

Option1: *Participants who would wish to engage in a Roundtable on any of the 8 subthemes should provide a title within the selected subtheme, a brief of the discussion and the names and a short bibliography of the panelists (maximum of 3) by **16 May 2021** to the conference secretariat on eeasa2021secretariat@mie.ac.mu. The session will be chaired by a moderator and the session will be of a maximum of 1h30.*

Option 2: *The organiser of the conference will propose a title for the Roundtable and will invite potential speakers to debate on the title. The speakers will then submit a short resumé of their contribution to the conference secretariat on eeasa2021secretariat@mie.ac.mu by **16 May 2021** and again there will be a maximum of 3 speakers and chaired by a moderator for a 1h30 duration.*

➤ E-Poster

All e-posters will be uploaded on a special webpage on the conference website.

All participants can visit eposters and access the videos. They can post their questions to eeasa2021@mie.ac.mu. The presenter will answer to any queries during the parallel e-poster sessions.

SAJEE publishes research papers, think pieces and viewpoints. **Contributors who wish to have their papers considered for publication in SAJEE are advised to follow the guidelines for SAJEE publication** (<https://www.ajol.info//index.php/sajee>) **to write their papers.**

Deadlines for submission will be announced at the conference.

4. Informal articles and session reports in EEASA's ***Environmental Education Bulletin***. The Bulletin is published online on EEASA's webpage, and includes informative articles on projects, news snippets, programme updates, letters, reviews of new resources and creative contributions.
